I Safety

II Construction / Capital Improvements

A. HMGP

Phase 1 for the Engine Upgrades at Stations 1&4

- Tier rating determination was received from EPA and we have received the approved regulatory permits from LA DEQ.
- Revised 100% P&S expected soon, SBPG will advertise in the next 90 days.

Phase 1 Safe Room Design at Stations 1&7

- SBPG will advertise this month.

B. FEMA Public Assistance

Pump Station #6 Pump repair / Hangers at PS#6&7

- Received 100% bid docs.
- Will be advertised after Erosion Repair project.

Pump Station #6 Erosion Repair

- Design and bid documents are complete.
- Preparing to advertise.

C. Non-Federal Levee Certification

- 100% designs for Phase 1 have been received and LBBLD is complete with all real estate acquisition.
- 100% designs for Phase 2 are complete, real estate acquisition is complete, awaiting approval of HMGP funding in order to advertise.

III O&M

A. Non-Federal Levee

- No significant issues or deficiencies.
- Regular O&M is ongoing.
- Animal damage repairs is an ongoing activity.

B. Mississippi River Levee

- No significant issues or deficiencies.
- Conducting regular O&M on levees and floodgates.

C. HSDRRS

- A small amount of movement was identified during quarterly inspections on LPV 146 adjacent to the tie in with LPV 147. Monoliths 799 and 800 on LPV-146 were impacted.
- A closer visual inspection was conducted 7/27/16, the full inspection report and distress report have been provided to CPRA for submission to USACE.
- USACE follow up inspection of Caernarvon Gate Paint issue scheduled for 8/19/16.
- Animal Damage repair is an ongoing activity.

D. Drainage Canals

- Continued routine maintenance along drainage canals.
- Grass cutting and herbicide application.

E. Pump Stations

- No issues associated with heavy rainfall during the last week.
- Continuing routine preventative maintenance.
